Enhancing Reading Comprehension - (Registration Deadline – March 25, 2019) This workshop will explore a variety of strategies to increase student understanding of text. Discover teaching strategies that will deepen students' understanding of text before, during, and after reading. Learn how to activate background knowledge, help students generate deeper thinking questions to predict, develop mental images to visualize, determine main ideas and details, find information to make inferences, synthesize information, and use fix-up strategies to get back on track when comprehension starts to break down.

<u>Developing Engaged Readers</u> - Participants will explore the components of an engaging high school ELA reading program that supports all readers. Explore how to do book talks to help connect students with texts that they will enjoy. Participants will examine how to utilize book clubs and whole class texts to engage their high school learners.

A Novel Approach: Whole-Class Novels, Student-Centered Teaching, and Choice by Kate Roberts - Book

Study — (Registration Deadline — March 1, 2019) Be inspired by new thinking and fresh strategies on how to use whole class texts and how to support individual student learning. PD funds may be used to purchase Kate Roberts' book *A Novel Approach*. Participants will read the book and then attend a one-day session unpacking the main ideas from the book which include how to read literature deeply, identifying and supporting individual student needs, choosing whole class texts, planning to teach texts and reading strategies, differentiating, conferring, teaching mini-lessons, and doing read-alouds.
