All graduating grade 12 students in Horizon School Division are eligible to apply for this bursary. Three bursaries will be awarded annually:

- Two All-Around Youth Leader Awards - \$1500 each awarded in 2020
- One Dedicated Sports Leader Award - \$1500 awarded in 2020

Selection Process:

The Humboldt Broncos Legacy Bursary is open to all Grade 12 students in Horizon School Division. Students interested in applying must submit their completed application by March 25, 2020, to the principal of their school. Applications must include:

- Completed application form.
- An essay outlining the merits of the applicant that should be taken into consideration. (Maximum 500 words)
- Two letters of recommendation from a community member. For example:
 - Teacher;

- School Staff Member;
- Coach;
- Employer;
- Elder;
- Member of the Clergy.

- Applicant's Most Recent Transcript.

Principals must complete a Humboldt Broncos Legacy Bursary Rubric for each applicant and submit completed application packages, along with rubrics, to the Director of Education through Horizon School Division's interoffice mail run the week of April 6-9. Applications received after April 9 will not be eligible for consideration.

Submitted applications will be reviewed by the selection committee and used for determining the award recipients.

A selection committee comprised of members of Horizon School Division's Administrative staff, along with Board Members from the Humboldt Broncos Memorial Golf Tournament and Legacy Awards program will determine the winners.

Winners will be announced in May 2020.

Recipients of the Humboldt Broncos Legacy Bursary will be required to sign a media waiver and provide their social insurance number and confirmation of enrolment in a post-secondary institute before the bursary will be awarded. Winners have up to two years, following their graduation, to claim the bursary. The total amount of the bursary will be reported on a T4A and must be included in the recipient's taxable income in the year of receipt. This amount is eligible for a scholarship exemption.
