There are no grade 10-12 classes during final exams (Monday, January 25th to Thursday, January 28th, 2021). Students are allowed to go home after each exam ONLY if they have brought a note from their parents giving them permission to do so. Please be aware that by granting this permission, Three Lakes School and staff are NOT responsible for your child once they leave the school, and if they leave, will not be able to take the bus home at the end of the day. Please provide your homeroom teacher with this note no later than Wednesday, January 13th, 2021.

Final Exam Rules and Information

- 1) All grade 10, 11 and 12 classes are comprehensive finals.
- 2) Students MUST NOT have a cell phone or other electronic device on their person during a final exam in any of their classes (leave your device in your locker).
- 3) Other items that are NOT allowed in the examination rooms include: purses, book bags and backpacks, coats, hats, books or notes (unless requested by the teacher), and calculator covers (leave these at home).
- 4) TALKING: Students may not talk, whisper or exchange information in any way with another student.
- 5) ARRIVE EARLY: Show up to school at least 15 minutes before your examination.
- 6) LATE ARRIVALS AND EARLY EXITS: Once you are in an exam, you MUST remain for **one hour minimum**. Once an hour has passed in an exam, late arrivals will not be allowed to write the exam.
- 7) LEAVE ALL EXAM MATERIALS: You are NOT allowed to take examinations or examination materials out of the examination room, including any tear out pages or rough draft materials.
- 8) If your exam is a provincial departmental examination:
 - Find your designated seat
 - Follow the Head Examiner's instructions regarding the preparation of the booklet and checking of your examination materials.
 - When finished, raise your hand before getting up. An examiner will double check your exam, have you clear your calculator (if a math or science exam) and give you permission to leave the exam room.
- 9) QUIETLY LEAVE THE AREA ONCE FINISHED: Be considerate of other students who are taking exams, as well as other classes. Go to the designated classroom to prepare for other exams or leave the school. In the designated classroom you will be quietly preparing for other exams, reading, or working on other course material.
