Important Final Exam Rules and Information

- 1) Students MUST NOT have a cell phone or other electronic device on their person during a final exam in any of their classes (leave outside of the room).
- 2) Other items that are NOT allowed in the examination rooms include: purses, book bags and backpacks, coats, hats, books or notes (unless requested by the teacher), and calculator covers (leave these at home).
- 3) TALKING: Students may not talk, whisper or exchange information in any way with another student.
- 4) ARRIVE EARLY: Show up at school at least 15 minutes before any provincial departmental examination.
- 5) LATE ARRIVALS AND EARLY EXITS: Once you are in an exam, you MUST remain for **one hour minimum**. Once an hour has passed in an exam, late arrivals will not be allowed to write the exam.
- 6) LEAVE ALL EXAM MATERIALS: You are NOT allowed to take examinations or examination materials out of the examination room, including any tear out pages or rough draft materials.
- 7) If your exam is a provincial departmental examination:
 - Find your designated seat
 - Follow the Head Examiner's instructions regarding the preparation of the booklet and checking of your examination materials.
 - When finished, raise your hand before getting up. An examiner will double check your exam, have you clear your calculator (if a math or science exam) and give you permission to leave the exam room.
- 8) LEAVE THE AREA ONCE FINISHED: Be considerate of others not only in your exam but in other examination rooms. Once finished go to an area away from any exams or simply leave the school once your exam is over.
- 9) *Recommends – In order for a student to be eligible they must: maintain an average of 80% or better; have regular and punctual attendance (fewer than two unexcused absences or three unexcused lates); have returned all textbooks and library books and paid all school debts; and display respect for property, peers, and authority. There will be no recommendations in level 30 subjects (Grade 12). Students must write final examinations in a minimum of two subjects per semester. The subjects written, if all marks are above 80%, are the subjects in which the student attains the lowest marks.*

Reminder: There are no classes for grade 10-12 students during final exams (Thursday, January 25th to Tuesday, January 29th). They will be allowed to go home after each exam ONLY if they have brought a note from their parents giving them permission to do so. Please be aware that by granting this permission, Three Lakes School and staff are NOT responsible for your child once they leave the school. Please provide your homeroom teacher with this note no later than Wednesday, January 17th, 2018.
