## **Important Final Exam Rules and Information**

- 1) All grade 10, 11 and 12 classes are comprehensive finals.
- 2) Students MUST NOT have a cell phone or other electronic device on their person during a final exam in any of their classes (leave outside of the room).
- 3) Other items that are NOT allowed in the examination rooms include: purses, book bags and backpacks, coats, hats, books or notes (unless requested by the teacher), and calculator covers (leave these at home).
- 4) TALKING: Students may not talk, whisper or exchange information in any way with another student.
- 5) ARRIVE EARLY: Show up at school at least 15 minutes before any provincial departmental examination.
- 6) LATE ARRIVALS AND EARLY EXITS: Once you are in an exam, you MUST remain for **one hour minimum**. Once an hour has passed in an exam, late arrivals will not be allowed to write the exam.
- 7) LEAVE ALL EXAM MATERIALS: You are NOT allowed to take examinations or examination materials out of the examination room, including any tear out pages or rough draft materials.
- 8) All school material, textbooks, etc. must be turned in prior to writing the final exam in each subject.
- 9) If your exam is a provincial departmental examination:
  - Find your designated seat
  - Follow the Head Examiner's instructions regarding the preparation of the booklet and checking of your examination materials.
  - When finished, raise your hand before getting up. An examiner will double check your exam, have you clear your calculator (if a math or science exam) and give you permission to leave the exam room.
- 8) LEAVE THE AREA ONCE FINISHED: Be considerate of others not only in your exam but in other examination rooms. Once finished go to an area away from any exams or simply leave the school once your exam is over.
- 9) *Recommends – Recommends will NOT be given in any grade 10, 11 or 12 classes.*

**Reminder: There are no classes for grade 10-12 students during final exams (Thursday, June 20 to Wednesday, June 26, 2019). They will be allowed to go home after each exam ONLY if they have brought a note from their parents giving them permission to do so. Please be aware that by granting this permission, Three Lakes School and staff are NOT responsible for your child once they leave the school, and if they leave, will not be able to take the bus home at the end of the day. Please provide your homeroom teacher with this note no later than Wednesday, June 12, 2019.**
